Paper submission

The working language of the conference is English. Prospective authors are requested to submit full paper proposals (4-6 full pages) prepared according to IEEE double column conference proceedings format (use Microsoft word 2003 template):

Submissions must present original ideas, must not have been published elsewhere (conference or journal) during the review period. Each author is allowed to submit and present not more than 3 papers. All submitted papers will be blind reviewed by at least two independent reviewers. Each accepted paper must be presented at the conference by one of the authors. Accepted papers will be submitted for inclusion into IEEE Xplore subject to meeting IEEE Xplore's scope and quality requirements IEEE Xplore. Papers not presented will not be published.
